Senior League Baseball is open to 13, 14, 15 and 16 year-olds playing on regulation size fields with 90 foot baselines. There is leading, stealing, balks... almost everything associated with major league baseball (except that, unlike school-ball and other leagues, everyone plays in every game).

The Senior League is actually two leagues, the Junior League for 13 and 14 year-olds, and the Senior League for 14,15 and 16 year-olds.

Our objective is to make playing baseball fun and the senior league lets you play without the pressures associated with school-ball. Yes, you can do both! In fact, many of our players also play school-ball, but may not get enough play time or a chance to play different positions. After your school-ball practice or game, you can come out and show us what you've learned.

You'll see all skill levels and with the help of the older players, most of our younger players become quite competitive over the season.

The NEW Senior field is located at the Little League Complex. There is a full draft every year and try-outs will be in March.

We plan on having a 12 – 14 game schedule and there will be Playoffs, which every team makes. We also enter teams in the Williamsport Tournament.
